How to Audition:

Check the Requirements section on the Auditions page for the group you are auditioning for.

Choose to do either an in-person audition OR to submit a recorded audition.

In- person auditions- September 18:

Sign up for a time using the Sign-up link on the auditions page.

You will be asked to play scales and a short solo piece. There may be a short sight-reading piece. Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your audition time to allow you to tune and warm up.

OR Recording audition-due September 18:

- 1. Recording Order: At the START of your recording, please state your name and your grade for the 2021-22 season.
- 2. Begin with scales (Prelude Strings D major; Encore Strings C major and g minor; Encore Band- 2 scales, 1 octave, your choice; CCYO Strings: C major and a minor, 2 octaves, Winds and Brass: C major and chromatic scale, 2 octaves).
- 3. Perform the solo of your choice.
- 4. All recordings should be made in one continuous take with no editing. The audio and video quality of the device you use to record will not affect your audition.
- 5. All string recordings should be sent to Dr. Kivrak at kivrak@yahoo.com and all woodwind and brass recordings should be sent to Ms. Mato at takakomato@gmail.com.
- 6. Please upload your recording to an online storage site (Google Drive, iCloud, Dropbox) and send a non-restricted shareable link in your email. Please contact a Director with any questions.
